- USED TO SPIN THREAD OR YARN FROM NATURAL FIBERS (COTTON, WOOL, ETC)












## LABOR MOVEMENT

■ INDUSTRIALIZATION WAS SLOW AFTER THE 25+ YEARS OF WARFARE IN FRANCE

### 1840s: **GERMANY**

 BEGINNING IN 1840s & TAKING OFF AFTER UNIFICATION (1871), GERMANY CAME TO RIVAL THE BRITISH INDUSTRIAL OUTPUT (GERMANY=#1 INDUSTRIALIZED NATION IN THE WORLD BY 1914)

### 1870s: **JAPAN**

• JAPANESE INDUSTRIALIZATION FOLLOWED THE MEIJI RESTORATION (RAPID MODERNIZATION)

## 1890s: **RUSSIA**

TSAR NICHOLAS II BEGAN SLOW PROCESS OF INDUSTRIALIZATION LAGGING BEHIND THE WEST





AKA THE TECHNOLOGICAL REVOLUTION, WAS THE RAPID INCREASE IN INNOVATION FROM 1870s INTO THE 20<sup>TH</sup> CENTURY W/INTRO OF CHEMS, STEEL, PRECISION MACHINE

## GLOBAL EFFECTS

DECLINE OF ASIAN/MIDDLE EAST SHARE IN GLOBAL MANUFACTURING:

### IRONWORKS IN INDIA

INDIAN IRONWORKS PRIOR TO THIS PERIOD WERE WORLD RENOWNED (SEE MUGHALS). BUT BRITISH ARRIVAL/COLONIZATION LED THE BRITS TO SHUT DOWN/OUTLAW THE MINES AS IRON COULD BE USED TO HELP AID REBELLIONS AGAINST THE BRITISH RAJ

SHIPBUILDING IN INDIA/SE ASIA
SIMILAR TO IRON, AS THE BRITISH CAME
IN, SHIPBUILDING IN INDIA WAS
RESTRICTED OF COMMANDEERED FOR
BRITISH USE. SE ASIA WAS SIMILARLY
AFFECTED BY CHINESE, PORTUGUESE, &
DUTCH ARRIVAL IN THE SPICE TRADE.

INDIA AND EGYPT
BOTH WERE IMPORTANT CENTERS
